



Know all men by these presents that we Reason
Reagan Noah Reagan & Lot Reagan of the County of Hendricks
and state of Indiana are held and firmly bound unto
the state of Indiana in the sum of Four Thousand
dollars lawful money of the United States, for the
payment of which well and truly to be made and
done we bind ourselves our heirs, executors
& Administrators jointly and severally firmly
by these presents Sealed with our seals and
dated this 11th day of February 1839

The condition of the above obligation is such
that if the above bound Reason Reagan will truly
and faithfully discharge the duties and perform the
trusts committed to him as guardian of the persons
and estate of Cary Reagan and of the estate of
John Reagan infant sons of Lefe Reagan deceased
during the minority of the said Cary & John, and
render to this court (Hendricks Probate court) a just
and true account of his said guardianship when
he shall be thereto required then the above
obligation is to be null and void, otherwise to be
and remain in full force and virtue in law
