Bellevue Warrick County and State of Indiana  
do make and publish this my last will  
and testament:

First, I desire that all of my property,  
both personal and real estate be sold, by  
private or publick sale, and upon such  
terms of credit or otherwise as my executor  
may think proper.

Second, I give and devise to my beloved  
mother fifty dollars, to be paid of the first  
money that shall accrue from the sale  
of my property.

Third, I give and devise to Cornelius  
B. Hunt two books, McDonald's Treatise and Chitty  
on Contracts.

Fourth, I give and devise to my  
wife, after my indebtedness shall have been  
satisfied, all the remainder of the proceeds of  
my entire estate. The same to be held and used  
by her Father, Cyrus Hunt, as he may think best  
for her benefit, so long as she may remain my  
widow, but in case my wife should again marry  
these said proceeds shall be given to ~~hers~~ of  
my said wife, but in no case shall the proceeds revert  
to the husband of a subsequent marriage.

Fifth, I do hereby nominate and appoint  
Cyrus Hunt executor of this my last will  
and testament, hereby authorizing and  
empowering him to compromise, adjust,  
release, and discharge, in such manner as



he may deem proper, the debt and claims  
due me. I do also authorize and empower him  
to sell by private sale or in such manner, upon  
such terms of credit, or otherwise, as he may think  
proper all of my personal property, and real estate  
and deeds to purchase and to execute, acknowledge,  
and deliver, in fee simple.
