these presents, sealed with our seals and dated, this *16<sup>th</sup>* day of *May* A. D. 1849.

been duly appointed by the *Probate Court of the County of Hendricks*  
in the State aforesaid, GUARDIAN of the *Person of Reubin Richards,*

and letters of Guardianship have been duly granted to *him* by said Court  
Now therefore the condition of the above obligation, is to the effect following to-wit: That the said  
*John Baker,* shall faithfully per-  
form the duties of *his* said trust as such Guardian: Then and in that case said obligation  
shall be null and void, otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue in law.
