The same received on 28<sup>th</sup> October 1835 the sum of 104.23

Guardian of the estate of Robert Richardson an  
infant within the age of twenty one years, would  
state to your Honor that on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of  
September 1837 he purchased of and from John  
Parbee (with money belonging to said infant) for  
the sum of two hundred & twenty five Dollars, the West  
half of the South West <sup>quarter</sup> & North East of the Southwest  
<sup>quarter</sup> of Section No thirty two, Township Eighteen North, Range One East containing  
one hundred & twenty Acres, and took a General Warranty  
Deed therefor in the name, and for the use benefit  
and behoof of the said Robert Richardson, which  
said purchase so made as aforesaid the prayer  
may be confirmed by this Honorable Court,  
and that the said William J. Darnall Guardian  
as aforesaid, be credited for the said sum of  
two hundred & twenty five Dollars so paid out as aforesaid

of Henricks and State of Indiana are held and firmly bound  
unto the State of Indiana in the sum of fifteen Hundred  
dollars lawful money of the United States, for the payment  
of which well and truly to be made and done we bind  
ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly  
and severally, firmly by these presents Sealed with our seals  
and dated this ninth day of February AD 1835

The condition of the above obligation is such, that if the  
above bound William T. Darnall will truly and faithfully  
discharge the duties and perform the trusts committed to him as  
guardian of the Person & Property Robert Richardson as minor  
& heir to the <sup>of Landy Richardson</sup> Estate during the minority of the said Robert  
Richardson and render to this

Court a just and true account of his said guardianship when  
he shall be thereunto required, then the above obligation is to be void  
and of none effect, otherwise to be and remain in full force  
and virtue in law
