of said County, greeting:

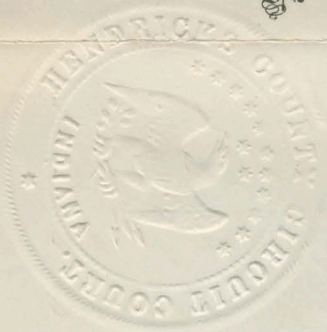
