The condition of the above obligation is such, that if the above bound *John Safenight* will truly and faithfully discharge the duties and perform the trusts committed to him as GUARDIAN of the person and estates of *Anna, Asa, and Eli Safenight, Heirs of the Estate Jesse Safenight* deceased, during the minority of the said *Anna, Asa and Eli Safenight*

and render to this Court a just and true account of his said guardianship, when he shall be thereunto required, then the above obligation is to be void and of none effect, otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue in law.
