and did then & there give bond and was
sworn into office as such Guardian
as aforesaid all according to law. And
your Petitioner would further represent
and show unto your Honor. And hereby
expressly charges that the said Edward Strong
as such Guardian has not truly and faithfully discharged
the duties and performed the trusts committed to him
as such Guardian of the Person and estate of
your petitioner but has wholly failed in
this to wit 1. he has not taken care of the
person of the said Harvey G. Shannon nor has
he clothed and educated nor caused to be educated
and clothed the said Harvey G. Shannon but
hath thereto wholly neglected and refused
2. the the said Edward as such Guardian has
wholly failed and refused to ^{take} care of the
personal and real estate of the said Harvey
G. Shannon and has wholly failed to make
any report of his proceedings to this Honorable
Court as he was bound to have done
all contrary to law. Wherefore he prays

that a notice with a copy of this petition annexed
thereto attached be ordered to issue out of
this Honorable Court directed to the Sheriff
of said County commanding him to notify
the said County ^{to notify} the said Strong
that, he appear on the first day of the next
term of this Honorable Court and show and
shew cause to the contrary, that he will
be removed from his said trust or
