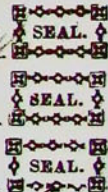

The above is a copy of my receipt to Repees.  
The Court did allow 1/5 expenses to be paid  
by the Heirs. as we expected, & was right  
it should be so. But did not allow  
them to pay Rail Road Stock & debt to  
Duckworth. These are the claims you  
will recollect that the Heirs portion would  
have been  $\$60^{00}$  if allowed, for which  
sum you know a note was taken of Mr  
Campbell & put in the hands of Judge  
McAtee, which note I now send you.  
I would have sent you all these things  
sooner only that there was a misunderstanding  
about the 60 $\%$  note, & the statement made out  
by Carruthers the Atty was lost. But on reser-  
-day Dunlap & all gave up that I was right.  
So here is the note with the balance of the  
estate, & as I wrote you before there will be  
no need of paying anything for collecting



these notes as I will do it for nothing

So I had to return the original draft & have another issued for \$87.65 instead of \$2.90, taking off the \$5.25. — Hoping you will understand it & all the right — the Receipt need not be stamped.
