The undersigned a ^{who is} Mother-in-law of Arcadia Summer aged about sixteen years would represent to said Court that the said Arcadia is the owner of the undivided one fifth part of the West half of the West half of the South west quarter of Section Twenty and the East half of the South East quarter of Section Nineteen (except ten acres on the west side of said half quarter) subject to the dower right of Rebecca Summer widow of Caleb Summer deceased, all in Township Fourteen North of Range two East estimated to be worth Three hundred and fifty Dollars and personal property worth about thirty or forty Dollars and that she has no guardian to take care of the same he therefore prays that some suitable person be appointed Guardian for her for that purpose
