Know all men by these presents that we Ezra Hinshaw & John B. Hadley of the County of Hendricks
and State of Indiana are held and firmly bound
unto the state of Indiana in the penal sum of
Five Hundred Dollars lawful money of the United
States for the payment of which well and truly to be made
and done we bind ourselves our heirs Executors and administrators
jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed
with our seals and dated this the 11th day of February
A.D 1839

The condition of the above obligation
is such that if the above bound Ezra Hinshaw - will
truly and faithfully discharge the duties and perform the
trusts committed to him as guardian of the person and
estate of Elizabeth Siverts daughter of Michael Siverts
late of the State of Indiana during the minority of the
said Elizabeth Siverts and render to this Court for just
and true account of his said guardianship when he shall
be thereto required then the above obligation is to be
void and of none effect otherwise to bind and remain in
full force and virtue in law
