dollars, for the payment of which well and truly to be made and done, we bind ourselves, our heirs,  
executors, and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals, and  
dated this *Eleventh* day of *August* A. D. 1847.

The condition of the above obligation is such, that if the above bound *Allen Sharp*  
will truly and faithfully discharge the duties and perform  
the trusts committed to him as GUARDIAN of the ~~person and~~ estate of *Jacob Sharp Mar-*  
*garet Sharp and Simon Sharp* Grand children of *Jacob Walker*  
deceased, during the minority of the said *Jacob Margaret and Simon Sharp*

and render to this Court a just and true account of his said guardianship, when he shall be thereunto  
required, then the above obligation is to be void and of none effect, otherwise to be and remain in full force  
and virtue in law.
