Tolbee, William Buttery and Jesse Gibson all of
County and State aforesaid are held and firmly
bound unto the State of Indiana in the penal
sum of Seven Hundred and fifty Dollars
Lawful Money of the United States the pay-
ment of which well and truly to be made
As Witness our hands and seals this 16th day of
January A.D. 1832

The condition of the above obligation
is such that Whereas the above bounden Thomas
Tolbee has this day obtained from the Clerk of
the Hendricks Probate Court Letters of Admin-
istration on the Estate of Samuel Tolbee deced-
late of said County Now should the said
Thomas Tolbee well, truly and faithfully discha-
ge his duty as such Administrator according to
Law and promptly deliver over to his suc-
cessor to be appointed by said court if any
such ever ^{should} be appointed of such Estate all
the moneys and effects belonging thereto
and do all other acts and things according
to law that may be required of said Ad-
ministrator to do then and in that case
the above obligation to be void and of none
effect otherwise to remain in full force
in Law
