Know all men by these Presents that we George Tyler
and Daniel Browne of Henderson County Indiana
are held and firmly bound, and by these Presents
do bind our heirs and assigns, unto the State of In-
diana in the sum of three hundred dollars, the
payment of which well and truly to be made, wit-
ness our hands and seals this 6th day of Septem-
ber 1890

The condition of the above Obligation
is such that whereas George Tyler above named
is Guardian of his Minor children, to wit, Kelly
ann and Letitia Tyler for the purpose of collecting
and receiving of a certain Legacy arising to the said
Kelly ann and Letitia Tyler, from the Estate of
Azariah Higgins of Fayette County Kentucky
deceased. Now should the said George Tyler well
and truly discharge the duties of his appointment
as Guardian aforesaid, and well and truly ac-
count for all monies so collected by him as
Guardian aforesaid, and in all things comply
with the Statute in such case made and pro-
vided, then and in that case the above Ob-
ligation to be void and of no effect other-
wise to remain in full force and virtue
in law and Equity.
