of February 1859 Richard Ashorn was
appointed, by the Court of Common
Pleas of said County Guardian for
the said minors, and he hereby moves
and requests this Court to remove said
Richard Ashorn from his trust as said
Guardian for the following reasons
1st Failure to inventory the estate of his said
wards

- 2nd Failure to make reports as required by law
- 3rd Failure to account for monies had and
received belonging to his said wards
- 4th Converting ~~the~~ money belonging to
said wards to his own use.
- 5th His utter and total incapacity to manage
the estate of his said wards, and protect
their interest therein.
- 6th His total insolvency.

County, Greeting. You are hereby comman-
ded to cite Richard Osborn guardian of Joseph
Vansickel, to appear before ~~the~~ Court of Common
Pleas of said County on the 1st day of the next
term of said Court to be begun and held at the
Court house in Danville on the 18th day of
May 1863, then and there to answer the ~~com~~
petition of said Joseph Vansickel for his re-
moval as said guardian, and show cause
if any he has, why he should not be removed from
said trust, and to account for all moneys and
effects that have come into his hands, or with
which he is chargeable on account of said guar-
dianship. And have you then and there
this writ.
