bound John M Cominger will truly and faithfully
execute and discharge the duties and trusts committed to
him as Guardian of the person and Estate of
Lira Bernitz during the minority of the said
Lira Bernitz and render unto the Hendricks Probate
Court a just and true account of his said Guardianship
when he shall be thereunto required, then the above obligation
to be void, otherwise to be and remain in full force and
virtue in law.
