dated this *twelfth* day of *November* A. D. 1846.

The condition of the above obligation is such, that if the above bound *Simon T. Hadley*
will truly and faithfully discharge the duties and perform
the trusts committed to him as GUARDIAN of the ~~person~~ and estate of *Marrett Weasley*
heir to the Estate of John Weasley
deceased, during the minority of the said *Marrett Weasley*

and render to this Court a just and true account of his said guardianship, when he shall be thereunto
required, then the above obligation is to be void and of none effect, otherwis eto be and remain in full force
and virtue in law.
