these presents, sealed with our seals and dated, this 14<sup>th</sup> day of February A. D. 1847.  
Whereas the above named and bounden William F. Darnall, has

been duly appointed by the Judge of the Probate Court of the County of Hendricks  
in the State aforesaid, GUARDIAN of the Estate of Sydney West, Heir to  
the Estate of Maria West,

and letters of Guardianship have been duly granted to him by said Court  
Now therefore the condition of the above obligation, is to the effect following to-wit: That the said  
William F. Darnall, shall faithfully per-  
form the duties of his said trust as such Guardian: Then and in that case said obligation  
shall be null and void, otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue in law.

in the State of Indiana.

The undersigned, guardian of  
the estate of Sidney West would report, that  
the sum of Eighteen dollars & fifty five cents, received  
by him on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of November 1850, and  
reported to the Hendricks Probate Court at  
the May Term 1852, is all the money, and  
the only effects, belonging to his said ward which  
have come to his hands, and is all that  
undersigned has knowledge of, belonging  
to said ward. That the same was loaned  
at interest until the 16<sup>th</sup> day of December  
1852. Amounting to the sum of \$2.34 which  
added to the above sum makes — that  
his said Ward was, on the 16. day of last  
December, twenty one years of age - and  
on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of that month, he paid  
over the sum of Eighteen dollars, and  
has since paid the fees of his guardianship  
to the Clerk of this Court amounting  
to \$4.88 which added to above sum  
paid to ward, makes \$22.88. and for  
which he herewith files vouchers. One  
and two. And prays to be discharged  
January 25. 1853.
