been duly appointed by the *Probate Court of the County of Hendricks* in the State aforesaid, GUARDIAN of the estates of *Jessie Simpson West, Paulina West, Nicholas West, Mary C. West, Willis West, and Hiram J. West,*

and letters of Guardianship have been duly granted to *her* by said Court. Now therefore the condition of the above obligation, is to the effect following to-wit: That the said *Jerusha West* shall faithfully perform the duties of *her* said trust as such Guardian: Then and in that case said obligation shall be null and void, otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue in law.
