Know all men by these presents that we Isaac
Wiley and John Hollingsworth of the county
of Morgan and State of Indiana are fully
and firmly bound unto the State of Indiana
in the sum of five hundred Dollars lawful money
of the United States for the payment of which
well and truly to be made and done we
bind ourselves our heirs executors & adminis-
trators jointly & severally firmly by these
presents Sealed with our seals and
dated this 15th day of May 1839

The condition of the above obligation is
such that if the above bound Isaac
Wiley will truly and faithfully perform
the duties and trusts committed to him
as administrator of the estate of William
Wiley—deceased according to law then the
above obligation is to be void and of none
effect, otherwise to be and remain in
full force and virtue in Law
