A. D. 1851.


WHEREAS by the last will and testament of Samuel Gount

I Daniel Gount of the County of Hendricks and State of Indiana do make and publish this my last Will and testament hereby revoking and making void all former wills by me at any time heretofore made, First I direct that my body be decently interred and that my funeral be conducted in a manner corresponding with my estate and situation in life, and as to such worldly estate as it has pleased God to entrust me with I dispose of it in the following manner (to-wit), I direct first that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid as soon after my decease as possible out of the first moneys that shall come to the hand of my Executor from any portion of my personal estate. And for the purpose of raising money to pay my Just debts I direct that after my decease my beloved wife if she survive me shall have the privilege of selecting from my personal property a sufficient amount to pay all my Just debts and my executor shall sell the same at public auction on a credit of six months and the amount thereof secured in such manner as is usual in like cases to insure the full and punctual payment thereof, And I further direct that the remainder of my personal property after the payment of my Just debts together with all my household furniture shall remain the absolute property of my beloved wife during her life, I also direct that my beloved wife shall remain in possession of and enjoy all the profits of the farm upon which I now live (being the south east quarter of the south east quarter of section ten in township fifteen North of range two west and the North east quarter of the North east quarter of section fifteen in township fifteen North of range two west) during her Natural life. And I hereby make and ordain my worthy and esteemed friend William Barwell executor of this my last will and testament


