The first pettles and purneyor of protan Seundhip was Binjamix Welde. He arrived from this is the pping of 1836. Mr. Wellow purchased his first tract of land in Jordan Journship an April 10, 1843 from the United States of america signed by President Jyler. He bought another tract an Ducember 29, 1849 from the United States of america signed by President Jackery Daylow. a total of 720 acres was purchased by m. Welde. Mr. Welde donated this cland for the (Egypt) welch cimetery in Jordan Journahip. His daughter mary, was among the fust to be buried in the ground of the Egypt) welch Cemetery in 1841. (Condiants used to congregate on this land as Mr. Job. Bramble and another man found a tomahawk while digging a grane)

The Egypt road where the unitary is located was originally part of the old stage coach road which ran between the morthern and pouthern parts of Indiana.²

Around the year 1849 pioneers going mest to this new homeotead, to make a new life traveled through this part of the country. A magon train must through jordan Vounthip.
