History of Christian Church



(Reprinted from Daily Reporter of May 31.)

THE Martinsville Christian Church was organized in June, 1836. The charter members were Mr. and Mrs. Apolas Hess and son; Mr. and Mrs. Benjamin Sweet; Miss Harriet Sweet; Mr. and Mrs. Perry M. Blankenship; Mr. and Mrs. James Jackson and Miss Pattie Jackson. The first meeting was held in the home of Mr. and Mrs. Blankenship. The membership grew rather rapidly and soon there were added Mrs. Perminter M. Parks, Mrs. Patterson, Mr. and Mrs. B. W. McCoy and Mrs. Robert McNaught. Rev. Joseph Faccett, of Columbus, was the first minister.

The eldership was made up of Messrs. Sweet, Jackson and Blankenship. In 1851 Noah J. Major was ordained as an elder by James M. Mathes. The late Mr. Major served as elder and minister of this church, preaching funerals and leading in the church work when the church had no regular pastor. He probably did more for the church in marrying the people of the church and community and conducting funeral services than any man who has ever served the church. The church building was dedicated April 24, 1892. Previous to this time the membership met in the building now occupied by the Artesian Laundry. Z. T. Sweeney preached the dedicatory sermon. W. B. F. Treat was the pastor and also served as chairman of the building committee. C. G. Renner, William C. Mitchell, Dr. Charles Seaton, John M. Clark, J. C. Kiefer, Samuel M. Mitchell, Samuel Tucker and A. M. Cunning constituted the building committee.

A list of the pastors of the church include Joseph Faccett, J. T. Edmonson, Thomas P. Connelly, James C. Mathes, Wilson Smith, Madison Evans, Levi Hanson, Jonathan H. Henry, H. W. Cure, P. M. Blankenship, Joseph H. Baxter, James F. Sloan, L. C. McGowen, William H. Boles, A. J. Frank, W. B. F. Treat, A. L. Grim, W. O. Moore, T. M. Wiles, I. N. Grisso. This brings the history down to the present century. I. N. Grisso and A. L. Grim are the only men in this long list that are living at the present time. Since the beginning of the century, A. L. Ward, Theodore Freed, A. E. Cole, M. W. Yocum, C. W. Cauble, E. R. Edwards, Ray Montgomery and Paul Boyer, the present pastor, have served this church. All of these men are living to rejoice in the splendid new building.

Cease, my dear friend, to cling to these party names and distinctions; away with them all; and let us call ourselves only Christians after Him from whom our doctrine comes."—Life of Luther by Mitchelet, page 262.

John Wesley: "Would to God that all sectarian names were forgotten, and that we, as humble, loving disciples, might sit down at the Master's feet, read His Holy Word, imbibe His spirit, and transcribe His life into our own."

Robert Stuart MacArthur (Baptist), New York City: "The name of Presbyterian, Congregationalist, Methodist and Baptist, however much we may love it and however loyal we are to it now, is to give place to that which is above every name. The day will come when those dashing waves of time and eternity shall strip off every name but one. Not our name, but the name of our Lord and Savior, our Prophet, Priest and King, will abide, and amid the light of earth and the increasing glory of eternity, that name alone shall be read, Jesus Christ."
