In the name of God Amen
 I Asa Burt of the County of Orange and State of New
 Jersey being weak in body but of sound and perfect mind
 and memory thanks be to almighty God for the same and
 considering the uncertainty of this mortal life do make and
 publish this my last Will and Testament in manner and
 form following (Viz) after all my just and lawfull debts
 are paid I will and bequeath unto my loving wife
 Rachel Burt all my property both Real and Personal
 during her natural life with a particular Request that
 she Rachel Burt take in to her special care and protection
 her three youngest Children Cordina Merab and Rachel
 Burt and carefully raise and educate said Children
 in such manner as she Rachel Burt may deem most
 advantage to said Children without she or them being
 accountable for the Expence thereof in any way whatsoever
 Secondly after the death of my wife Rachel Burt or so soon
 as she may deem it necessary my will is that my son Jacob
 Burt receive the quarter Section of land on which I
 now live together with a bed and bedding and a small
 man with a harness which he the said Jacob Burt
 has now in possession with full power to sell and convey
 the same as he may think proper and advantage
 Thirdly after the death of my wife Rachel Burt as a
 above mentioned my will is that the Remainder of my property
 be equally divided betwixt my six Daughters Viz Joannah
 Peters Louise Thain and Cordina Merab Rachel and
 Caroline Burt (after those who are single have
 an amount of property equal to those who are
 married) and have left the family Lastly I
 save my mortal body to be buried at the direction
 of said Burt and my wife Rachel Burt whom
 I appoint said Executors and Executrix of this
 my last Will and Testament
 In Witness where of I have hereunto set my hand

and seal this 13th day of August 1828

executors named therein file bond in the Clerk's office with a penalty
of One thousand Dollars with Samuel Stallcup as his security and
that he otherwise qualify to act as executor according to law

In the name of God Amen, I John Swin of the County
of Orange and State of Indiana being sick and weak in body but
of sound mind and disposing memory (for which I thank God) and calling to
mind the uncertainty of human life, and being desirous to dispose of all
such worldly estate as it has pleased God to bless me with
I give and bequeath the same in manner following that is to say
1st I give to my wife Mary Swin all my estate both real and personal for
and during the term of her natural life, except such as has heretofore been pro-
vided for, for our maintenance and support
2ndly After the death of my wife Mary Swin I give all my estate both
real and personal except such as heretofore been provided for for our support
and maintenance to my children equally to be divided among them and
to be enjoyed by them forever
