 doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall be
 the same again by the mighty power of God
 and as touching such worldly Estate wherewith I ha
 pleased God to Bless in this life I give devise and
 dispose of the same in the following manner first
 I give to Betsy Carr my dearly beloved Daughter
 my Executors) The premises wherewith I now live with
 all its appertinances containing fifty acres of land
 more or less lying and being in the County and State
 aforesaid in Town three north Range one East
 Section thirty in the district of lands offered for
 sale at Jeffersonville it being part of a Tract of
 Land that Adam Hostetter bought and purchased as
 per deed in my name together with all the Home
 hold and kitchen furniture and every other species
 of Property that is mine to have and to hold
