furniture during her widowhood or until my eldest  
son arrives to lawfull age and as much of my  
stock of Horses cattle Hogs and Sheep and farming  
implements at the discretions of my Executrix & Executor  
to raise and support my children

 and premises during her widowhood or until my  
 Oldest son comes of age (which may first happen)  
 If she chuses and then to be equally divided between  
 my wife and Children She and share a like

6<sup>th</sup> Moreover it is my Will and desire that my Children  
 should be put out to suitable places where they may  
 be brought up to usefull occupations at the discre-  
 tion of my Executors and Executor lastly I ordain  
 and appoint my beloved wife Mary Darrock and  
 my Brother Durum Darrock sole Executors & Executor  
 of this last Will and Testament

And I do hereby utterly disallow revoke and disannul  
 all and every other Testament Wills Legacies bequeathed  
 and Executors any wise by me named Testifying and  
 confirming this and no other to be my last Will  
 and Testament
