my last Will and Testament Revoking all others and  
it is my desire that my Estate both Real and personal  
be disposed of in the manner following to wit

First of All I give and bequeath unto Elizabeth  
my dearly beloved wife all the movable property that  
stands in need of and two Beds and furniture  
during her widowhood or lifetime and for her to keep  
as much of the movable property sufficient for her  
and back to keep house also I give unto my Daughter  
Forty Four and three fourths acres of Land as the  
Line is already run during her widowhood provided  
she is able to pay the Children up if not  
the Land is to be sold to pay them and if there is  
any left for her to live upon during her widowhood  
then to be Equally divided between her Children  
I Except one Road through where the new is turning  
East and west through the said Land for the benefit  
of all my Children where the well is

Item I give to my three sons Stephen Benjamin  
 and John one English Shilling each a piece  
 they having had their share before  
 Item I give unto Robert and Noah my sons my  
 old plantation containing ninety <sup>three</sup> acres to be divided

 line Running an East direction a cross the middle  
 of the well to a stake in the meadow there a  
 South Course to a stake there East Course to a  
 stake there North as far as if the land had been  
 Equal Divided thence East to the other line and  
 the said Noah is to maintain his Father and  
 Mother with the assistance of Robert helping him  
 to build a House and getting them firewood & send  
 the said Noah so to do she may rent out his part  
 of the land for her maintenance all the rest of my  
 Personal Estate is to be sold and the money given
