In the name of God amen, I Joseph Harlow of the County
of Orange and State of Indiana being weak of body but
of perfect in mind calling to mind the mortality of
my body and it appointed for all men to die

1st it is my will that I be decently buried and all my
just debts be paid by my executors hereafter named
and I will and bequeath unto beloved wife Ruth
Harlow her maintainance of my farm when I now
live during her natural life time, One horse by the name
of Dark, Two milk cows and calves and four head of sheep,
and one fourth part of the house hold and kitchen furniture
and two hundred and fifty dollars in cash to be at
her disposal forever

2nd I will and bequeath to my daughter Deborah Jones
Three hundred dollars in cash and the east half of
the south west quarter of section twelve in Township one
north of Range one west containing eighty acres of land to her
and her heirs for ever.

3rd I will and bequeath to my son Jonathan Harlow the
north east quarter of section fourteen Township one north
of range one west and four acres three rods and twenty
poles of the south side of the south east quarter of section
eleven in Township one north of Range one west beginning
at the south east corner of said quarter section thence
running north of west one hundred and ten poles thence
south fourteen poles to the section line to him his heirs
for ever and my set Blacksmith Goals to him his heirs
forever

4th I give and bequeath unto my son Nathan Harlow
the south west quarter of section eleven in Township one
north of Range one west and the south west quarter of

Item 6th I give and bequeath unto ~~son~~ in law Archibald Mcaulder the south east quarter of section eleven in Township one north of Range one west except four acres thru woods and twenty poles which is willed to Jonathan Garlow of the south side of ^{said quarter} section twelve and two acres where the meeting house and burial is an to him and his wife Hannah and their heirs forever and thirty dollars in cash

Item 7th I give and Bequeath unto my daughter Mary's Children namely Mary Ann, Mary and Thomas Maris To wit I will and bequeath to my little grand daughter Mary Maris the south east quarter of the north East quarter of section eleven in Township one north of Range one west to her her heirs forever

To wit I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Mary Ann Maris fifty acres of land of the East End of one hundred acres of land I own where Tom Butler lives say of the south side of the north west quarter of section twelve in Township one north of range one west to her her heirs forever

Item I will and bequeath to my grand son Thomas Maris fifty acres of land that is to say a the west end of one hundred acres where Tom Butler lives, the south side of the north west quarter of section twelve in Township one north of range one west to him and his heirs forever

Item I will and bequeath unto my Children namely Jonathan Garlow Nathan Garlow, My daughter Mary Maris Children to have an equal part Hannah Mcaulder, that is to say all my money that may be on hand and likewise my quarter section of land to be sold by my executors ^{hereafter} named that being the south east quarter of section thirty five in Township one north of two west to share and share alike after all just debts is paid to them their heirs forever and my house and lot in Paoli, ^{and burial}

Item I will and bequeath ^{to the society of friends where our meeting house is} my two sons Jonathan & Nathan Garlow and Archibald Mcaulder my whole and sole executors to act and transact all my business and sell and convey all my Real and personal estate and to have full power in law and equity in manner and form aforesaid as could do myself signed sealed and delivered in the presence of this fifth day of the 7mo. 1845
