5th I give and bequeath unto my sons John Freeman and Daniel Freeman all my stock of Hogs and Sheek and Cattle Except the Cows before mentioned and my Croquet saw to John Freeman and Stephen Crisp suman

6th I give and bequeath unto my son Joshua Freeman my sledges and gears and one sled and all my farming utensils and all the hills and bees and one half of Come & Bacon and one Vm Barrel and Phamus Chalk by Journal

7th I gave unto my granddaughter Jane Dean one Pitta Disk her Chaise & Richard Davidsons Journal

It is my will that my Executors shall divide or chose some person to divide the property willed unto my Daughters Fanny and Rebeckah

It is my will that my late Huskinds wearing apparel be divided between my three sons John Daniel & Joshua Freeman

And Lastly I appaint my sons John Freeman and Joshua Freeman my sole Executors to this my Last Will hereby Revoking all other Wills by me made Ratifying this to be my Last Will and Testament and no other
