Item first that all my just debts be paid
I will and bequeath to my beloved wife Hannah Halladay the quarter section of Land I now live on during her natural life then it is my will that the above Land be sold and equally divided amongst my children namely Abigail Mary Sarah Henry Robert Deborah Hannah Rebecah and John Halladay

It is my will that my beloved wife Hannah shall have my mare Skip with all my beds and bedding also it is my will that my wife shall have all my frame held furniture

It is my will that my daughter Abigail shall have the bed and bedding that which is called Fern

It is my will that my daughter Mary shall have the bed and bedding which she now claims; It is my will that my daughter Deborah shall have the bed and bedding that she now claims; It is my will that my daughter Hannah shall have the bed and bedding which is now called Fern; It is my will that my daughter Rebecah shall have the bed and bedding which is now called Fern

It is my will that my three sons Jacob Henry & Robert shall have my Dove Mare and sorel horse Fryer. It is my will that my a horse mentioned three sones shall have my blind horse, It is my will that my three last mentioned sones shall have my watch and Rifle Gun It is my will that my beloved wife shall have my wagon & gear also all my corn and meate, It is my will that my wife

Intentions for the use and support of the family It is my will that what cash I have in hand shall be left to my Wifes disposal for the use of my family support, It is my will that all the balance of my Estate be equally divided amongst my Children namely Margal Mary Jacob Henry Robert Deborah Hannah and Rebecca Hallsday I hereby constitute and appoint my two sons Henry and Robert Hallsdays my Executors of this my last will and testament Ratifying this and no other Writings in the presence of

I William Gawdy of the County of Orange County and State of Virginia being weak of body but of Perfect mind and memory do make this my last will and Testament First I recommend my soul to the hands of Almighty God who gave it first Then my body to be buried in a decent and Christianlike manner Then first after all just debts and funeral charges being paid I give and bequeath to Catherine Hamilton of Pittsburgh State of Pennsylvania Fifteen Dollars all the rest of my estate to Sarah Gawdy of Chambersburgh who is a minor in the care of Samuel Cooper of the same place and I hereby appoint and constitute Thomas Lindly Gentleman and Thomas Fulton Executors of this my last Will and Testament and further direct them to forward to Samuel Cooper a true and legible statement of the proceedings and in Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this second day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixteen done in the presence of
