

William Irvine Will

Be it remembered that I William Irvine of the County of Orange, and State of Indiana, of sound mind and memory, considering the uncertainty of this life, do make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following- To wit- 1<sup>st</sup> I give and bequeath to my beloved son William Irvine, all my real estate being the tract of land on which I now reside containing ninety acres, to embrace all my freehold estate whatever, lying and being in the County of Orange aforesaid to have and to hold to him the said William Irvine his heirs and assigns forever. 2<sup>nd</sup> I give and bequeath to my beloved son Jesse A. Irvine, Two shares in the Branch at Bedford of the State Bank of Indiana. And 3<sup>rd</sup> I give and bequeath to my said son William Irvine, all the residue and remainder of my personal estate, goods and remainder of chattles, and effects whatever, subject to the conditions or legacies following, to wit; I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Sarah Letter the sum of Twenty Dollars, which I desire my said son William Irvine to pay to her as soon after my decease as convenient. And I also give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Anna Baker the sum of Twenty dollars, which I desire my son William Irvine to pay as aforesaid- and I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Eliza Spear the sum of twenty dollars to be paid by my said son William Irvine as aforesaid. And I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Martha McLane the sum of twenty dollars to be paid by my son William Irvine as aforesaid. And I give and bequeath to the Children of my deceased daughter Lucinda Legarden the sum of Twenty dollars to be paid by my son William Irvine for all of which said several bequests my said son William Irvine will execute his notes payable as soon as convenient, as soon as this will shall have been proved- And I will and direct that my son as a further consideration of his having received all my real and the greater part of my personal Estate shall provide for and maintain my unfortunate daughter Jane Irvine during her natural life. And I hereby appoint William Irvine sole executor of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all others. In witness whereof I the said William Irvine hereunto subscribed my name and set my seal this \_\_\_\_\_ day of September 1846 Wm. Irvine (Seal)


John Mc Cracken will
