

Margaret Elizabeth Jane Wagner's will.

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Know all men by these presents that I Elizabeth Jane Wagner of the County of Orange and State of Indiana being weak in body but of sound mind and disposing memory do make ordain publish and declare this my last will and testament as follows - that is to say

First I commended my immortal soul to God who gave it, and my body to be buried in a decent Christian style. Secondly as to such worldly effects as it has pleased God to entrust to me I will and bequeath all my estate both real and personal to my two sisters Mary Ann Wagner and Martha Sarah Wagner and my two Brothers who are remaining at home with my Mother James H. Wagner and Orrin M. Wagner to be equally divided among them each to receive one fourth part thereof - My Brother John having left home and disposed of his interest in the lands inherited from our Father it is not my will that he should receive any portion of my estate.

Given under my hand and seal this 18th day of June A.D. 1852
