And Thirdly that my dear wife have all my real and personal property to do and dispose of as she may think proper except my two Clay bank Horses. Then I will and bequeath to two sons Ansel and David to give in part to them as their own property at my death. And Thirdly that after the payment a certain Bond I give to Agnes Cobb his at the death of my wife and she is hereby to make legal distribution as she may think most equitable and Just taking consideration what I have heretofore given to my oldest children heretofore. And Lastly I hereby constitute my dear wife Margaret my only Executor for the faithful performance this my will
witness my hand and seal this 14th day of September A.D. 1850
