


Zechariah Noorman's Will

I Zechariah Noorman of the County Orange and State of Indiana being weak of body but of sound mind and memory do make publish and ordain and declare this my last Will and Testament. That is to say that in lieu of Dower in any and all my real Estate I give and bequeath to my wife Nancy one hundred and sixty acres of land to be selected by her from among the lands I have - which when selected will be in lieu of all Dower in Lawn Lots and the residue of my lands - And it is further my will that so much of Lot No. 84. in the Town of Paoli as I own be sold by my Executors to the best advantage and the money arising therefrom be equally divided between my children - and that the lands so selected by my wife in lieu of Dower she shall hold in fee simple to herself and heirs - And it is further my will that all my personal Estate be disposed of and distributed as the law provides in case of persons dying intestate

And I hereby appoint Charles H. Moore Executor of ^{this} my last will and testament given under my hand and seal this 9th day of August A.D. 1847. Zechariah Noorman 

Signed sealed published and declared by Zechariah Noorman in our presence to be his last will and testament and signed by us in his presence and in presence of each other at his request John Baker David Osborn

Be it remembered on the 25th day of August 1847 personally come into the Probate Court of Orange County John Baker and David Osborn and being duly sworn say that they saw Zechariah Noorman sign his given name, and at his request John Baker signed the remainder of his name and that Zechariah Noorman published and declared this writing as his last will and Testament, and that they believe he was at the time of its execution of sound mind and memory and not under coercion or restraint and that they signed their names thereto as witnesses in the presence of said testator at his request signed John Baker, David Osborn subscribed and sworn to in Court 25th August 1847 - Jeremiah Milson Clk
