ed between my two sons John and James next
I give to my Daughter Hannah two hundred &
ten dollars I also appoint that all my farming
tools be given to my two sons John and James
equally divided I also will and appoint that my son
Daniel have all the money that will be left after the
above mentioned payments be legally made and that
it be applyed properly for his maintenance I also
appoint that my wife Elizabeth and my son John
be appointed Executors of this my last will and tes-
tament As Witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and seal this twenty fourth day of January
in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight
hundred eighteen

mentioned Then it is my Will that my just debts be
paid with my funeral charges be paid out of my Estate

I then give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Jane
Morris during her natural life and widowhood for
the purpose of raising the Infant parts of the family
and her severe conveniences as she may think proper
the my home hold and kitchen furniture together
with all the farming utensils and two heil of horse
Beasts Two Cows two Breeding sows Eight heil of hogs
for the purpose of keeping for the next season and
all the present crop of Corn Except one hundred
Barrels and eight of the large hogs for Pork for the
present season also the use of my Land and plantation
where an I now live being one quarter section during
her life and widowhood and then to be sold and
its proceeds to be equally divided amongst my then
my eldest son William Excepted in consequence of
a young horse I now give and bequeath to him being
the one claimed by him

I then give and bequeath to my Eldest Daughter Nancy
one young cow that she may claim

It is then my desire that the a above mentioned hundred
barrels of Corn together with all my unbequeathed
property be sold at the discretion of my Executor
for the purpose of Paying the remaining instalments
yet remaining on the aforesaid Land and after which
settlement any money that may remain It is my
wish that my Wife should have it for the necessary
use of the family and any that can then be saved

It is my wish that it should be kept on Interest
till a final divide be made Then I give and bequeath
to my Daughter Nancy one heil and furniture

I do hereby appoint James Depee my Executor of
this my Will and testament requesting that they may
see the same punctually performed and I hereby
revoke and make void all other Wills and Testaments
by me made and do publish and declare this to
be my last will and testament

I David Brauer of Indiana State and the County of Orange do make my Last Will and Testament as follows that I give and bequeath to my Wife Stigal one half of the plantation that I now live on also my loved slave two Cows and two sows and the household furniture during her natural life or widowhood and the other parts of the plantation I give to my son David and after my wife is done with her dower then I give and bequeath it all to my son David my son James I give one dollar My daughter Mary Wilson I give one dollar my son Alexander I give and bequeath thirty dollars in property my son John I give one dollar my Daughter Jennie I give and bequeath one Dollar my Daughter Betsey I give and bequeath one dollar after my just debts are paid the residue of all my property and money I give and bequeath to my son David my Will and desire is for Daniel Brauer now and my wife Stigal to Execute my Last Will and Testament Given under my hand and seal this fifth day of July 1818

Be it remembered that heretofore to wit on the 20th day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and nineteen the Last Will and Testament of David Brauer deceased was produced to me William Hoggatt Clerk of the Circuit Court for the County of Orange and proven by the affirmation of John Daugherty and John Wallace two of the subscribing witnesses then to and Stigal Brauer and Daniel Brauer now the Executors then named performed all that the Law requires to enable them to obtain a letter Testamentary Wm Hoggatt Clk
