

Record of Wills

Be it remembered that on the 9th day of August 1846 personally appeared before me Jeremiah Wilson clerk of the Probate Court of Orange County William Lindley who being of lawful age and duly affirmed deposes and says that he was acquainted with Joseph Farlow in his life time that the will annexed is the same will that he saw the said Joseph Farlow execute during his life time that he saw the said Joseph Farlow sign the said will and that he attested & subscribed the same in the presence of said testator - and that Joseph Melles was present at the signing & acknowledging of said will and also signed the said will in the presence of such testator that said Joseph Farlow was of full age to devise property and that he was of sound mind and memory and that the said Joseph Farlow did not make said will under coercion nor restraint as he verily believes and further saith not.

I, Jacob Moulder of the County of Orange and State of Indiana being of sound mind and perfect memory and calling to mind the uncertainty of time do make and ordain this to be my last will and testament this eighteenth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty five revoking all others heretofore by me made I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Elizabeth the use and benefit during her widowhood of the land whereon I now live to wit, the south east corner of section thirty three in township two

north of range one east also the field situate in
the N. west corner of section four in townships one
north of range one east and half of the field in the
northeast corner of the N. west qr of the same section
also the southeast qr of the N. west qr of section thirty three
in township two north of range one east. It is my will
that if she shall marry that she shall only be en-
titled to one third of the interest in said lands
with the exception of the southeast qr of the northwest
qr of section thirty three in townships two north
of range one east. which will in that case be other-
wise disposed of. I also give unto her forever one
horse her choice of such as I may be possessed of one
cow and each five head of hogs and five head of sheep
her choice and two hundred dollars in money two
beds and furniture and as much other household
and kitchen furniture as will be sufficient for her
to keep house conveniently and comfortably

2nd I give and bequeath unto my daughter Susanna
Lindley the sum of one hundred dollars

3rd I give and bequeath unto my son John the
sum of fifty dollars

4 I give and bequeath unto Betsey Jane Moulder
(daughter of Alexander Moulder dec.) the sum of fifty
dollars

5th I give and bequeath unto Archibald Moulder
(son of Alexander Moulder dec.) the sum of fifty dollars

6th I give and bequeath unto my son William the
sum of one hundred dollars, or if he instead thereof
he should prefer to take the southeast qr of the
N. west qr of section thirty three in townships two
north of range 1 east at the expiration of his mothers
widowhood or one hundred and twenty dollars he
may also

7th I give and bequeath unto my daughter Sally
the sum of one hundred dollars

8th I give and bequeath unto my daughter Lydia the
sum of one hundred dollars

9th I give and bequeath unto my daughter Maria
the sum of one hundred dollars

10th I give and bequeath unto my daughter Betsey Lane the sum of one hundred dollars.

11th I give and bequeath unto my son Lewis the the lot of land known as the north east qr of section four in township one north of range one east excepting his mother's corner

12th I give and bequeath unto my son Archibald the west qr of section four in township one north of range one ~~East~~ excepting his mother's corner

13th I give and bequeath unto my son Oliver the qr of land whereon I now live viz. the south east qr of section thirty three in township two north of range one east, when his mother's claim shall cease

14 It is my will that the residue of my property both real and personal be sold by my executors either at private or public sale as they may think most advantageous to the estate and the proceeds arising therefrom together with the balance of my estate to be divided into eleven equal parts, one of which I give to each of my children viz. Susanna, John, Sally, William Lydia Mary Ann Lewis, Archibald Oliver and Betsey Lane. It is my will that the remaining part be equally divided between Betsey Lane Moulder & Archibald Moulder children of Alexander Moulder deceased

15 It is my will that if any of my children die or be dead before me leaving no issue that his her or thirs legacy or legacies be equally divided among the surviving heirs

Lastly I constitute and appoint my sons Archibald and Oliver executors of this my last will & testament subscribed and acknowledged the date above written in presence of us.

John Throop Will

I John Throop of Orange County Indiana do make and
publish this my last will and Testament hereby revoking and
making void all others wills by me at any time heretofore made

First. I direct that my body be decently interred and my funeral
be conducted in a manner corresponding with my estate and situation
in life. as to such worldly estate as it has pleased God to entrust
me with I dispose of the same in the following manner to wit,

first I direct that all my last debts and funeral expence be
be paid as soon after my decease as possible out of the first money
that shall come into the hands of my executor from any of my estate
real or personal. I also direct that all my estate both real and personal
including my property of any and every discription be by my
executor sold at public auction or at private sale for cash or on cre-
dit as to him may seem most proper and profitable to those concerned
and in such manner as may be usual in like cases and to effectuate
this my intention I hereby vest my executor with full power and
authovity to dispose of my real estate in fee simple or for a term
of years or otherwise in as full and ample a manner in every respect
as I could myself do if living. I also direct that out of the
avails of my estate thus disposed of one hundred dollars be
paid by my executor to John S. Moore & one hundred dollars
to Rebecca Lane Moore the one the son the other the daughter of my
daughter Lane Moore - that in like manner fifty dollars be paid
to Martha Lefler (my adopted grand daughter) also I direct that
two dollars be paid to my son Oliver M. Throop, (I having paid
him a child's full share previous to this time) and further that the
residue of said avails be equally divided share and share alike among
-st my other children to wit Lane Moore, Sophia C. Throop, John J. Throop,
Ann R. Wood and Susanna Wolf.

And I hereby make and ordain my son John J. Throop
sole executor of this my last will and Testament
