 State of Indiana, do make and publish this my last will and testa-
 ment in manner and form following first I do hereby appoint Samuel P.
 McClain executor of this my last will and testament and I direct him
 my said executor soon after my decease to collect what money I have out-
 and settle of my just debts and funeral expences and the expence of settling
 up my estate and the residue of the money to be laid out of for saddles,
 and bureas for my children my daughters first commencing Emily Scott
 and on ~~as far~~ ^{as far} as the money will go as they need them saddles or bureaus
 I want my motherelay. Nancy Scott and my children to stay to gather and
 I will as for all my personal property to remain where it is for the use
 and benefit of my children untill raised (which is Emily Scott, Martha
 Ann Scott, William D. Scott, Samuel C. Scott, Margaret Scott and as
 they come of age or marry, to be made equal with my daughter Hannah
 C. Hill which I have advanced to her one hundred and seventeen dol-
 lars in property after all are made equal as aforesaid I want my two
 sons William D. Scott, Samuel C. Scott to have all of the stock and farming
 utensils, an waggon except the sheep; they are to be dividid equal amongst all
 of my children the household and kitchen furniture to be dividid equal
 amongst all of my children daughters, if my children should break up
 house keeping, I want the same division to take place. In testimony

 February, eightien hundred and fifty two. interlined before signed.
