I Thomas self of the County of Orange and State of Indiana do hereby make and publish this my last will and Testament hereby revoking and making void all former wills by me at any time heretofore made - First I direct that my body be decently interred and that my funeral be conducted in a manner corresponding with my Estate and situation in life, and as to such worldly Estate as it has pleased God to intrust me with: I direct that my beloved son James A. self have all my real Estate which I am at this time seized of also all the personal property that I shall possess at the time of my death, provided always that the said James A. self shall provide for and maintain me and furnish ^{me} with all the necessaries of life so long as I ^{shall} live, and shall pay or cause to be paid all my just debts and funeral expenses, and pay or cause to be paid to Hannah Stout Twenty dollars she having before this time had the remainder of what I allowed her, also pay the heirs of Elizabeth Ferguson, to wit: Joseph S Ferguson and John W Ferguson fifteen dollars each within Twelve months from my decease my other children to wit: William A. self, Thomas H. self, John self, Phillip self and George self having previously to this time had what I considered their portion of my real and personal Estate and I hereby make and ordain my beloved son James Alexander self and my ~~esteemed~~ friend William Kealey Executors of this my last will and Testament in, witness whereof I Thomas self the Testator have hereunto set my hand and seal this 19th day August 1849 Thomas Self Seal


Joseph Pounds Will

I Joseph Pounds of Orange County Indiana, do make and publish this my last will and testament in manner and form following

First I do hereby nominate and appoint my son in law Samuel R. Mc. Claim Executor of this my last will and testament.

and I direct my said Executor soon after decease to sell all my property both real and personal or mixed at public or private sale as he may think best on a credit or otherwise after allowing my wife Hannah Pounds all her rights in said property as allowed by law, to her deceased husbands Estate if she survives me, and after converting the same into money first to pay and satisfy all my last debts, and funeral expences, and the expences necessarily incurred in settling my business, and also a reasonable allowance to my said Executor for his services, and the balance whatev'er it may be to divide between my children and their heirs of such of my children as have deceased, so that the children of a deceased son or daughter shall receive the share that their deceased parent would have been entitled to if living share and share alike, and also to make deliver and acknowledge a deed or deeds in fee simple to all my real estate, to purchasers as aforesaid

I hereby revoke all former wills by me made.
