in township one north of range one west in the County  
of Orange and State of Indiana by her freely to be pos-  
sessed and enjoyed forever.

3<sup>d</sup> and lastly I nominate, constitute and appoint my love-  
ing wife Sarah Seybold to be sole executrix of this last will  
and testament, hereby revoking and disannulling all  
former and other wills by me, in any wise, made - ratifying  
and conforming this and no other to be my last will and  
testament. In witness whereof I hereunto set my hand and  
seal this tenth of June in the year one thousand eight hun-  
dred & thirty.
