

# Asolem Willson's Will.

In name of God Amen:


I, Asolem Willson, of the county of Orange and State of Indiana being weak in body but of sound mind and memory and considering the uncertainty of this mortal life but in hope of a blissful immortality and triumphant Resurrection through Jesus Christ, do make and publish this my last will and testament in manner and form following. That is to say. First, it is my desire that my funeral & other expenses be discharged as soon after my decease as convenient.

Secondly, I have given and do hereby give and bequeath to my beloved daughters Priscilla and Elizabeth all the money, bills, bonds and notes of which I may die possessed as well also as all money due and owing to me by book-account to be divided equally between them. Thirdly, it is my will that all my personal property except what is embraced in the above request to Priscilla and Elizabeth be sold by my executors hereinafter appointed as soon after my decease as convenient and that the avails thereof be divided into five equal shares which I give and bequeath as follows, to wit. To the children of my beloved daughter Polly one share - or one fifth part of the avails of my personal property not otherwise disposed of to be divided equally among them as they become of age. To my beloved son Nathan one share or one fifth part of my personal property as aforesaid. To the children of my deceased daughter Fanny one share or one fifth part of the avails of my personal property as aforesaid. To my beloved daughter Priscilla one share or one fifth part of the avails of my personal property in addition to what is embraced in the bequest to her & Elizabeth. To my beloved daughter Elizabeth one share or one fifth part of the avails of my personal property in addition to what is embraced in my bequest to her and Priscilla. Fourthly - it is my will that my real estate my Land be divided into five equal parts or shares of which I give & bequeath one share or one fifth part to the children of my beloved Polly. And I give and bequeath to my beloved son Nathan one share or one fifth part of my land or real estate. To the children of my deceased daughter Fanny one share or one fifth part of my land I give & bequeath. To my beloved daughter Priscilla I give & bequeath one share or one fifth part of my real estate. And to my beloved daughter Elizabeth I give & bequeath one share or one fifth part of my real estate or land of which I may be possessed.

And it is my desire and will that my beloved daughter Polly have and enjoy the use and profits of all and singularly the real and personal bequest to her children and during her natural life or untill they become of age the principal being secured to her children as aforesaid: And I hereby appoint my beloved son Nathaniel Willson Executor of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former wills by me made.

In testimony whereof I, Absolom Willson, have hereunto subscribed my name and set my seal this tenth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty five.
