I, Sumner A. Mason Clerk of the Posey Circuit Court, within and for the county of Posey aforesaid, hereby certify that Wallace Baker a ~~white~~ colored man has been duly Registered in my office, in pursuance of an "Act entitled an act to enforce the 13th Article of the Constitution, approved June 13th 1852;" that he is about 20 years of age; that he is a man of rather dark color rather inclined to be yellow and a boy of Pleasant Leavitt name about five feet 10 inches high that he was born in White County, Illinois and that he now resides in Posey County ~~Indiana~~ county, Indiana, and that the said Wallace Baker was a resident of the State of Indiana prior to the first day of November, A. D., 1851, and that the same was proven by examination under oath of John Warner of New Harmony
