AN EARLY CHURCH RECORD

1878 May (4), Fourth 78

Resolved that we believe it to be good for the cause that there be a gathering together of the brethren composing the Church of the Disciples in Spartanburg and vicinity, and reorganize believing the situation demands it. Many have died since we organized in May 1867 and many moved away from our midst.

A Church Record

The Church of the Disciples of Christ met at Spartanburg meeting house on Saturday the (11) day of May 1878 and agreed to still meet for worship and reorganize, with the understanding they take the holy scriptures for their rule of faith and practice. Agreeing to help one and each other, and all that may join themselves to us according to his word.
