minor children of John H. Nelson, who was a Private Co. A.
79 Regt Ind. Vols., in the service of the United States, are entitled to receive
pay at the rate of Eight dollars per month, commencing on
the Second day of November, 1864, and terminating on
the Third day of January, 1878.

Also, there shall be paid, from and after 25. July, 1866, an
additional sum of two dollars per month for each child named herein until arriving at
the age of sixteen years; provided such child has not died before that date. It is
further provided, that when only one of the above children is entitled, the additional sum
of two dollars per month shall cease to be paid from that date. The amount paid
hereon shall be equally divided among all the children while under sixteen years of
age, and is payable to their guardian Elias Leach.
