WAR OF 1812 MATCH CHALLENGE REACHES 60%

Our \$10,000 match challenge is now over 60%, thanks to the help of so many generous donors. We also thank the Tippecanoe County Area

Genealogical Society (TIPCOA) of West Lafayette, Indiana, which donated \$100, and the Society of the War of 1812 in the State of Indiana, which donated \$1,000.

ABOUT THE MATCH CHALLENGE: The Indiana Genealogical Society is aiding the Federation of Genealogical Societies' campaign to digitize the National Archives' collection of War of 1812 pension files, by matching every donation up to the first \$10,000 that is made between now and **June 30, 2011**.

INDIANA MARRIAGE INDEXING UPDATE

Our project with FamilySearch to create an [Indiana marriage index \(1811-1959\)](#) continues to grow.

Entries from Bartholomew County and Elkhart County have been added to the online index, bringing to 26 the number of Indiana's 92 counties that are included. FamilySearch estimates the project is now about 40% complete.

Our project to preserve and digitize [Hendricks County probate records](#) continues to make progress. More digital files have been put online in recent weeks - there are now over 360 probate cases online.
