County Indexes to Indiana's 1890 Soldiers Enrollment Lists

A CD-ROM in PDF format (accessible via the free Adobe Acrobat Reader) which contains a detailed index to the 1890 soldiers enrollment list for a particular county. The enrollment lists (which are housed at the Indiana State Archives, and have also been microfilmed) enumerated veterans of all past wars who were residing in the various counties of Indiana in 1890, or if they were deceased, information on their widows and children. The lists are a valuable resource for determining an ancestor's military service, and also function as a partial census substitute, particularly since the Indiana portions of both the 1890 census and the 1890 special census of Union veterans and their widows were destroyed. **85 of Indiana's 92 counties have indexes—the counties that do not have indexes are: Adams, Allen, Blackford, Crawford, Dearborn, Madison & Marion.**

Statewide Index to Indiana's 1890 Soldiers Enrollment Lists

A CD-ROM in PDF format (accessible via the free Adobe Acrobat Reader) which contains a combined index to the 85 county indexes that have been done. The combined index contains over 51,000 entries. **There are 7 counties that are not included: Adams, Allen, Blackford, Crawford, Dearborn, Madison & Marion.**

Statewide Index to Indiana's 1880 DDD (Defective, Dependent, Delinquent) Schedules

A CD-ROM in PDF format (accessible via the free Adobe Acrobat Reader) which contains a combined index to all 92 county indexes that have been done. The combined index contains over 17,000 entries. The 1880 DDD schedules (which were microfilmed) were a supplemental schedule to the 1880 federal census, with the census enumerator providing additional information on those who had been labeled as Insane, Idiotic, Deaf and Mute, Blind, Homeless Children, Inhabitants in Prison, or Indigent.

Indiana Cemetery Locations

A CD-ROM in PDF format (accessible via the free Adobe Acrobat Reader) which contains the locations/driving directions for the cemeteries in various counties:

- **Volume I:** Adams, Allen, Clinton, Elkhart, Johnson, Knox, Madison, Marion, Marshall, Morgan, Newton, Orange, Perry, Porter, Randolph, Rush, Shelby, Steuben, Sullivan, Union, Washington, Wells and Whitley counties.
- **Volume II:** Bartholomew, Blackford, Brown, Carroll, Dearborn, Delaware, Fayette, Fountain, Fulton, Grant, Hamilton, Hancock, Henry, Howard, Jay, Kosciusko, LaGrange, Lake, LaPorte, Miami, Monroe, Noble, Ohio, Pulaski, Ripley, Spencer, Tipton, Vermillion, Wabash and Warren counties.
- **Volume III:** Benton, Boone, Decatur, DeKalb, Greene, Hendricks, Jasper, Jennings, Lawrence, Martin, Montgomery, Owen, Parke, Pike, Putnam, St. Joseph, Starke, Switzerland, Tippecanoe, Vigo, Warrick and White counties.
- **Volume IV:** Cass, Clark, Clay, Crawford, Daviess, Dubois, Floyd, Franklin, Gibson, Harrison, Huntington, Jackson, Jefferson, Posey, Scott, Vanderburgh and Wayne counties.

- **Volume III**—a CD-ROM in PDF format (accessible via the free Adobe Acrobat Reader) that is 99 pages and contains approximately 125 entries. The PDF is fully searchable.
